Standards of Shared Governance Participation for Columbia College Faculty

The Columbia College Academic Senate, with its “shared governance” responsibilities as articulated in Assembly Bill 1725, recognizes that faculty members are expected to regularly and actively participate in a variety of shared governance roles without compensation beyond their base salary. Furthermore, it is reasonable to expect that each faculty member will contribute in multiple ways over the course of a given academic year and one’s tenure with Columbia College.
