Note to Student: Columbia College upholds California Education Code and California Code of Regulations, to be reclassified from a non-resident in a preceding semester. Establishing residence requires both physical presence in California for one year and one day prior to the beginning date of the semester for which you are applying and objective evidence of two to three forms of documentation showing intent to make California your residence, and be financial independent for other than a temporary purpose. The one year and one day residence period does not begin until you are present in California and have demonstrated clear physical intent to become a California resident

The burden of proof to clearly demonstrate both physical presence and the intent to establish residency in California and financial independence lies with the student. Failure to provide required residency information will result in determination of California non-resident. Additional documentation may be requested to assist a student's reclassification. Warning: falsifying information about citizenship, California residency, financial aid, and/or military status could result in: (1) criminal charges for perjury and/or fraud (2) student disciplinary action; and/or (3) accumulated monetary charges.

A Student must demonstrate and provide proof of residency by:

- Citizenship status
- Physical presence in California and intent to reside in California permanently
- Financial independence
- Military status

Part A: Legal Status (Title 5 54002 & 54045[c])

Has your immigration status changed since you last applied to Columbia College? Students must obtain citizenship status for at least one year and a day prior to the opening day of the term for which you are petitioning. Documentation is required to be submitted to clarify student's status. To establish California residency, you MUST be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, an applicant for permanent resident status, employment authorized, or possess a visa that does not preclude you from establishing domicile in the U.S.

Part B: Physical Presence and Intent to Reside in California (Title 5 54022 & 54024)

Have you resided in California longer than one year and one day before the start of the semester and intend to make California your permanent residence? OR have you attended an out of state college or university? Establishing residence requires both physical presence and objective evidence that there is the intent to make California your residence for other than a temporary purpose. The intent to make California your residence for other than a temporary purpose may be demonstrated in many ways. Upon review of documents submitted, additional documentation may be requested to assist a student's reclassification.

Part C: Financial Independence (Ed. Code 68044 & Title 5 54032)

You MUST provide proof of financial independence, ALONG WITH physical presence AND intent to make California your place of residence. If you are a dependent child and your parents are California residents who do not meet the physical presence are entitled to resident classification during the first year they are physically present in California; however, students must establish California residency thereafter.

Part D: Military Status (Ed. Code 58075.7)

Are you an active Military Personnel, stationed in California or the spouse or dependent of such person? Were you discharged from the military in a state other than California? Please submit the following documentations: Military ID, Military Orders and DD214.
