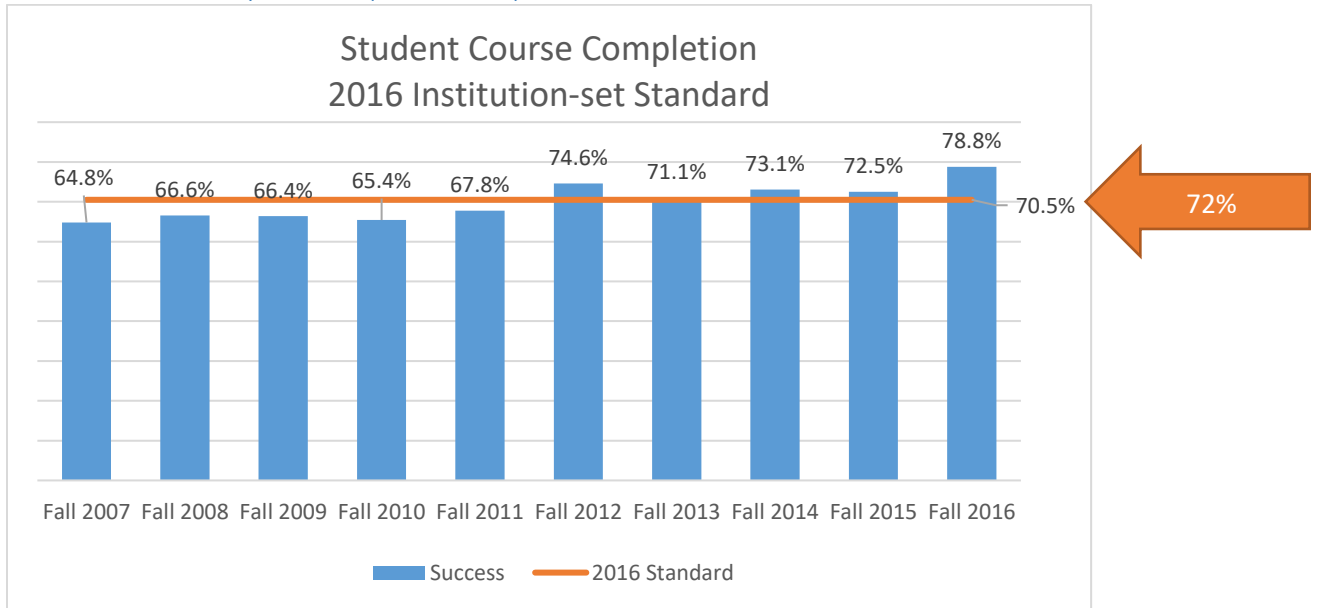


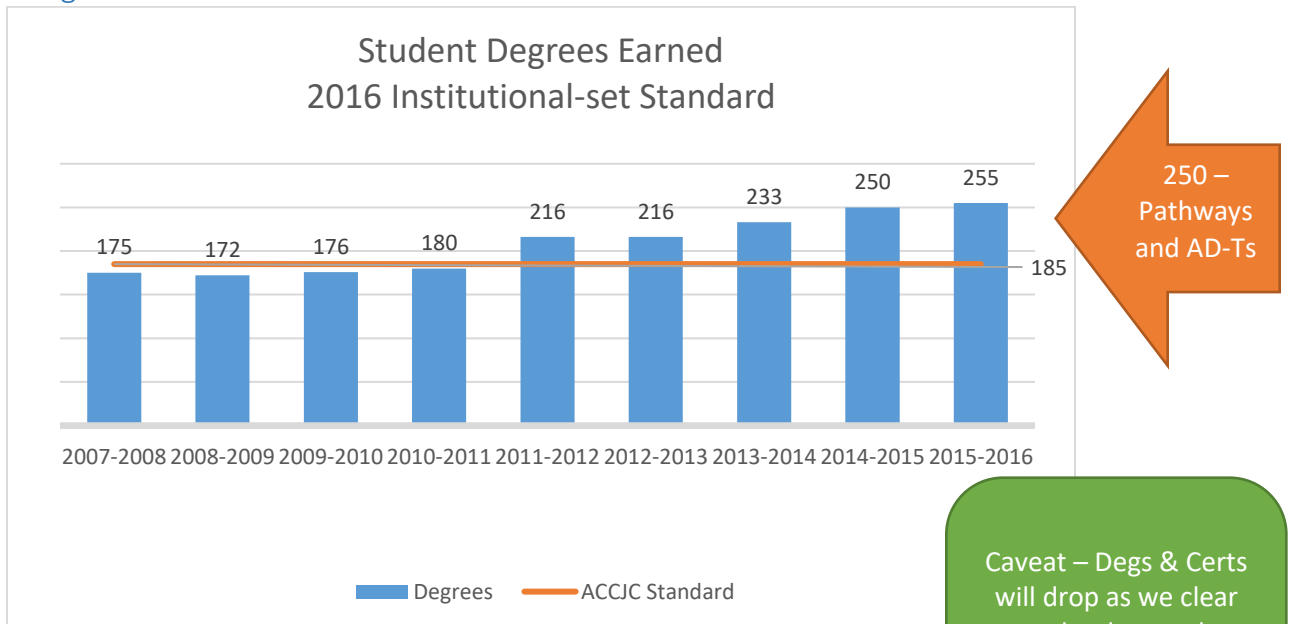
ACCJC 2016 Institution-set Standards by Actual Outcomes

Successful Course Completions (Fall terms):

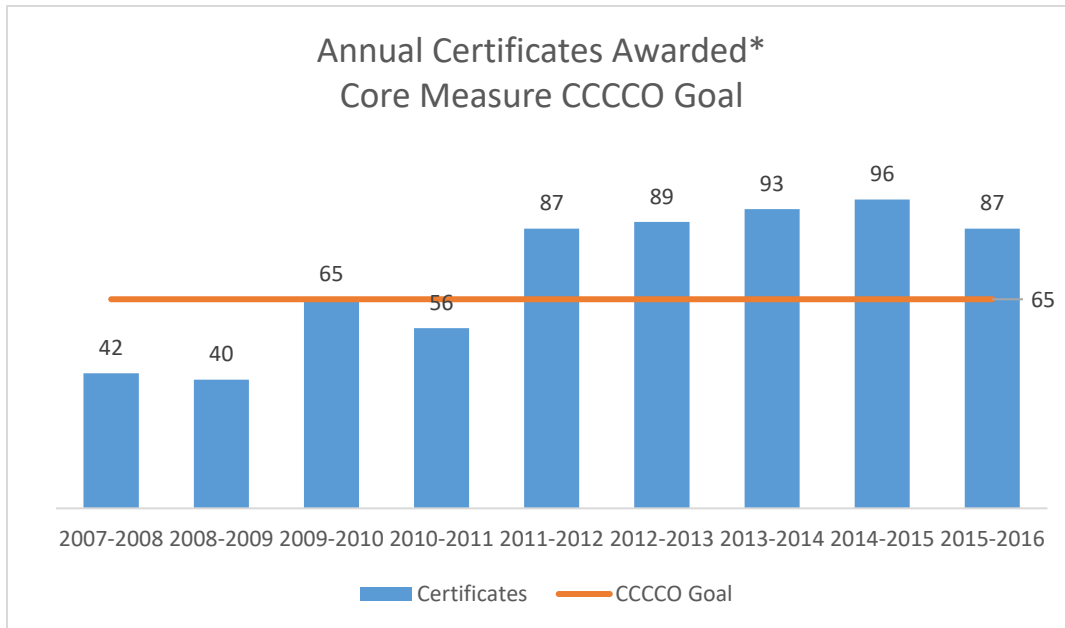


Annual Degrees Awarded:



Caveat – Degs & Certs will drop as we clear redundant and questionable degrees and cert. Set for now and explain when it happens.

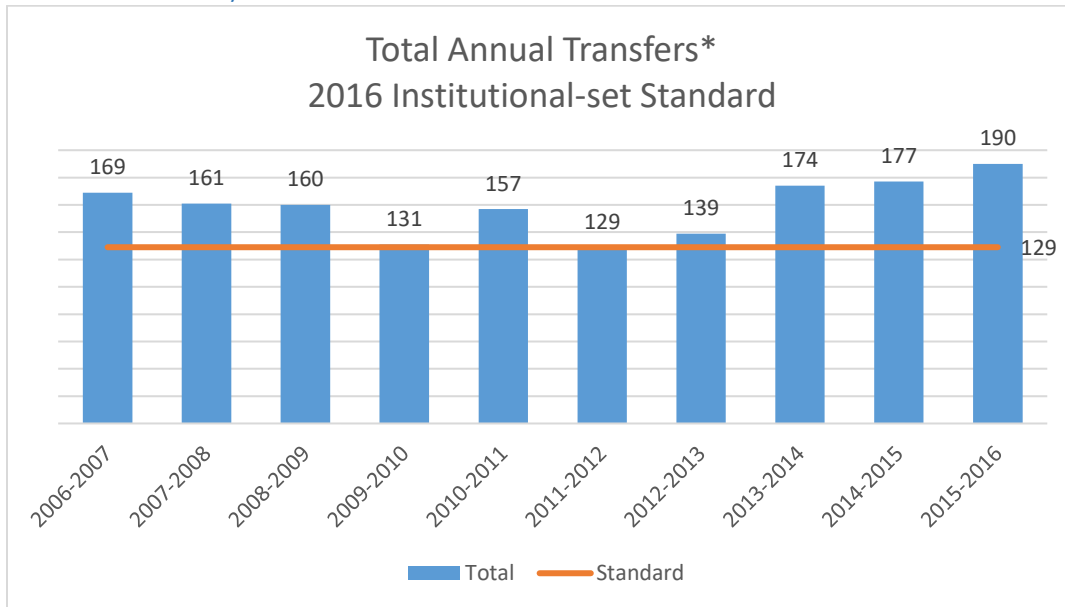
Certificates Awarded:

Annual Transfers to 4-year Universities*:

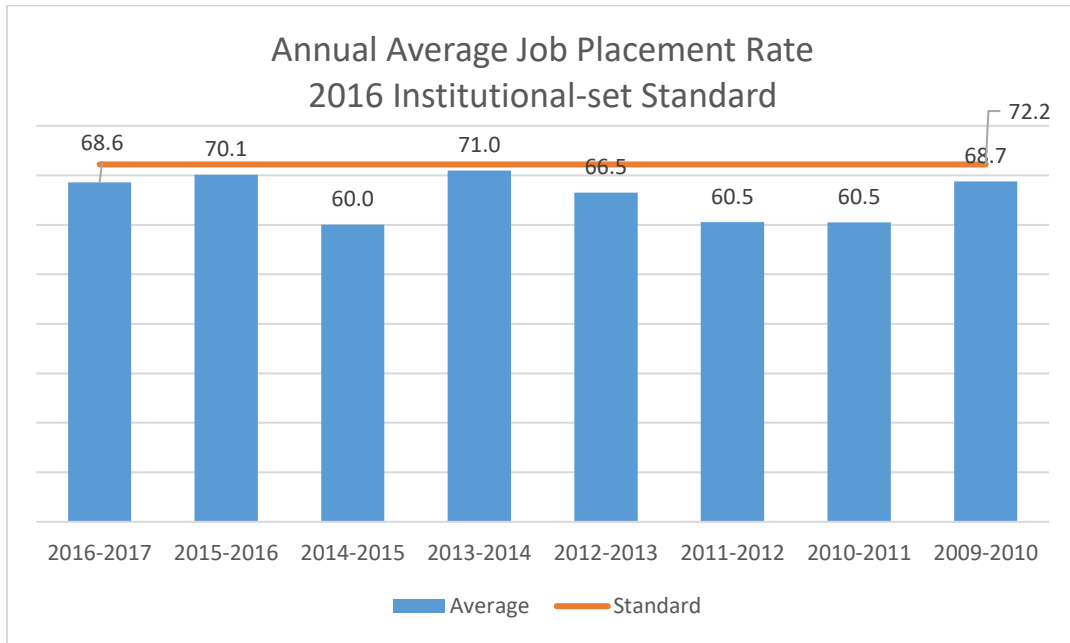


200 – Pathways and AD-Ts. Plus better transfer data soon with Strong Workforce tracking

CTE – Institution-set Standard for Job Placement Rate

The College does not have reliable job placement information for students; however, the Perkins Core Measures returns some job placement data. The following represents data obtained through the annual CCCC Core Measure Report. The ACCJC for the Annual report contains the annual Core Measure rates along with a long-standing goal of 72.2% job placement rate that was established as a goal with the CCCC over a decade ago.
