- **How to Read Class Search:**

1. If you see **CONL** for *location* **DINT** for *type*, **ONLINE** for *times*, and **ARR** for *days*, this is an online course in Canvas ONLY

**Explanation:** This course is fully online with no required days and times for meetings. This means the instructor will provide students with recorded class sessions. Therefore, there are no times or specific days for meeting. The instructor may also use announcements, assignment feedback, participation in discussions, and other methods, including optional Zoom meetings.

2. If you see **CCVSZOOM** for *location*, **LEC** for *type*, **SPECIFIED HOURS** for *times*, and **SPECIFIED DAYS** for *days* listed, this course meets in ZOOM on specified days and times

**Explanation:** Class meetings are most likely held through Zoom, much the same as a traditional face-to-face course. The course may include Canvas assignments and activities, but as is the case with face-to-face courses, Canvas is encouraged but not required.

**TIP:** Under the **IMPORTANT NOTES** for **each course**, it will indicate if a Zoom lecture is required, highly encouraged, or optional live attendance with recorded lectures as an alternative.

For example:

Attend Zoom sessions during scheduled times or view recorded lectures later in Canvas. OR Attendance is required in Zoom sessions during scheduled times.

3. If you see **CCVS ZOOM/CONL** for *location*, **LEC/DINT** for *type*, **SPECIFIED TIMES**, for *times*, and **ARR for days**, this is a hybrid Online and Face to Face

**Explanation:** This hybrid class meets online for the lecture portion, and the instructor will instruct the students when they are scheduled to come to campus for the lab portion.

4. If you see **an actual bldg. code w/ room number** for *location*, **LAB** for *type*, **SPECIFIED TIMES**, for *times*, and **SPECIFIED DAYS**, this is a lab that meets on campus!
