



Campus Security Timely Warning Bulletin

Crime(s): PC 245 – Aggravated Assault

Date: November 9, 2023

Location: Columbia College Parking Lot C & D

Case #: Tuolumne County Sheriff Dept

Suspect: Unknown

Incident(s):

On November 9, 2023 at 9:30pm an impromptu gathering of people occurred in the Parking Lot C and D, Student Housing of Columbia College. At 1145pm, during this event, a fight erupted between many unknown persons. During the fight a Columbia College student was struck in the face with an unidentified weapon. Campus Safety and the Housing Proctor responded to the parking lots; the unknown persons fled the area in a white Honda Accord. Campus Safety found a Columbia College student with injuries to his face. The student was unsure of what he was stuck by at the time and refused EMS. He arranged his own transportation to the Emergency Room. The student was treated for minor fascial contusions, a small laceration and released. Campus Safety notified Tuolumne County Sheriff Department (TCSD) who responded and completed a report. Campus Safety provided investigative leads to the TCSD of video surveillance.

On November 13, 2023 Campus Safety Management working in concert with TCSD detectives, determined that the Columbia College student was struck by a pistol. In this determination, the incident was elevated to a Clery Status Violation Report which requires this publishing of this timely warning. This investigation will be continued by the Tuolumne County Sheriff Department.
